Sexual Health

Your body can suffer from many diseases. Some are visible (pimples, fever, redness...) and others are not (you may not even know that you are sick).

That's why your body needs to be checked by health professionals. It is important to be tested. Screening is looking to see if you have a disease or not.

There are several screening methods, depending on the disease you're looking for:
- A blood test
- A smear for cervical cancer, for example, or another sexually transmitted disease
- A drop of blood on the finger to detect HIV AIDS, Hepatitis B or C
- HIV AIDS self-testing at home
- A mammogram (breast examination)

Many diseases can be treated very well, especially if detected early! A screening test will give you peace of mind if it's negative.

Abortion in France : a pregnant woman, even under 18, who doesn't want to continue a pregnancy, has the right to ask its interruption. Abortion is possible until the end of week n°14 of pregnancy (16 weeks after the first day of the last period). Abortion is free and can be done at the Planning Familial or in sexual health and education centres (CSES).
